

Puppy Sales Agreement

This contract is between _____, herein after referred to as "Seller" and _____, herein after referred to as "Buyer(s)".

In consideration of payment in full of the purchase price of \$ _____ Dollars by Buyer to Seller agrees to transfer to Buyer, subject to the terms and conditions contained in this contract, the ownership of one Male/Female puppy, herein after referred to as "Puppy" (regardless of age), from the mating of the sire and dam identified below.

1. Buyer MUST have new puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within 3 days of deliver or pick-up. The Seller must receive a copy of this puppy examination report within 7 days of puppy's appointment by United States Postal Service, Signature Confirmation.
2. The Seller guarantees that the said puppy described above will be free of adenovirus2, bordtella, distemper, parainfluenza and parvo virus for a Period of 15 (fifteen) calendar days after receipt of the live puppy by the Buyer(s). The Seller will provide a vaccination record. If the puppy is due for vaccinations, and the Buyer(s) fail to provide vaccinations on that day, this guarantee is null and void if the puppy contacts diseases that would otherwise be prevented by those vaccinations.
3. The Seller shall not be responsible for any medical cost incidental to the puppy after Buyer(s) receives the puppy. Seller guarantees the above puppy to be healthy at the time of sale. Seller does not assume any liability for any injury to said puppy after time of sale. If there is a problem with the puppy, Seller's veterinarian and Buyer's veterinarian must agree upon health reasons existed before time of purchase, provided the puppy has been properly cared for in Buyer(s) possession.
4. If puppy dies within 24 hours of purchase, Buyer(s) must have an autopsy performed by a licensed veterinarian at Buyer(s) expense to determine cause of death. If cause of death is due to problems existed before time of purchase and after Seller's veterinarian has examined the puppy, a replacement puppy is given. The replacement puppy will be of same equal value. A replacement will only take place if the above puppy has been properly cared for in Buyer(s) possession.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL A REPLACEMENT OF A PUPPY TAKE PLACE IF THE ABOVE CONDITIONS ARE NOT MET.

5. Seller is not responsible for immunity level, mites, pneumonia, any mange (including demodicosis, red mange, demodetic mange or sarcoptic mange), heatstroke, ringworm, conjunctivitis, fleas, and ear infections once puppy has left Seller's hands. Buyer(s) is/are responsible for keeping their puppy away from contaminated areas.
6. Seller is not responsible for immunity level, HOD, or ricketts (commonly seen by bowing of the legs). This is due to improper nutrition in the puppy's diet; by not feeding the puppy a Large Breed dog or puppy food. You must feed your puppy a Large Breed puppy or dog food!
7. If Buyer(s) plans to show said puppy, Seller does not guarantee that the puppy will become a champion.
8. The Seller shall provide the Buyer(s) registration certificate(s) for each puppy purchased. If the certificate(s) have not been received at the time of sale, the Seller will provide the Buyer(s) evidence that the registrations have been applied for, and upon receipt for the registries, the Seller will forward the certificate(s) to the respective Buyer(s).
9. If the Buyer(s) prefers commercial shipment: The Seller will arrange air shipment for the said puppy, however, the Buyer(s) will pay the cost of any and all arrangements and expenses for commercial shipment of the said puppy. The Seller shall not be responsible for the safety of the puppy while in transit to the Buyer(s), to include any and all incurred injuries as a result of transportation accidents.
10. After said puppy is received, the Buyer(s) agrees to provide all vaccinations and vet checks that may be needed to ensure a healthy life.
11. No replacement for temperament as this is environmental and Buyer(s) responsibility. Seller is not responsible for any damage that puppy might do at any age.
12. I guarantee your puppy to be free of any genetic defect for a period of 1 (one) year. If the said puppy happens to have some form of genetic defect, there will be 1 (one) option the Buyer(s) will have and it is as follows: A replacement puppy will be given of the same value & the first puppy will be returned to the Seller, In the event the Buyer(s) want a replacement puppy and there are none available at the time, the Buyer(s) will receive a puppy from the next Great Dane litter.
13. Seller is not responsible for a lost or stolen puppy.

This contract contains the entire agreement between the parties and no statement or verbal agreements made by either party that are not contained in this written contract shall be valid or binding. This contract may not be modified or altered except in writing and signed by both parties. Violations of this contract will constitute BREACH OF CONTRACT.

I have read and understand the stipulations of the contract and voluntarily agree to all elements, stipulations and provisions herein.
